

**GOVERNANCE****SCHOOL BOARD EFFECTIVENESS****USE OF SCHOOL-BASED ACCREDITATION AND PERFORMANCE DATA**

To meet the education goals of the State of West Virginia and such other goals as the Board may establish, the Board shall use school-based accreditation and performance data provided by the State Board of Education, as well as other available data, in Board decision making. To that end:

- A. State Goals. The Superintendent shall compile and share with the Board, at least annually, the education goals of the State of West Virginia.
- B. Data. Data to be used by the Board in decision making shall include, but not be limited to:
1. School report card results,
  2. District report card results,
  3. School standardized testing results,
  4. District standardized testing results,
  5. ACT and SAT results,
  6. College going rates,
  7. Attendance rates,
  8. WVEIS reports,
  9. Student, parent, teacher satisfaction surveys.
