

GOVERNANCE**FOREIGN EXCHANGE PROGRAM**

Foreign exchange students provide the youth of Ohio County Schools a unique opportunity to learn about cultures, languages, governments, religions, and customs they could not otherwise know as thoroughly. Therefore Ohio County Schools support foreign exchange programs by enrolling students in the schools and providing them educational opportunities on the same basis as residents and citizens.

All foreign exchange students must meet federal, legal, and regulatory requirements. The Office of Student Services and other designees of the Superintendent will coordinate enrollment procedures. Likewise, students of Ohio County Schools would benefit from visits and residence in foreign lands and the board encourages system cooperation with programs that provide these experiences.
